- 6TB Rebeca-Maria T** for always being kind top not only her friends but all of her peers.



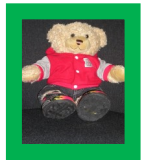

New Gate Entrance

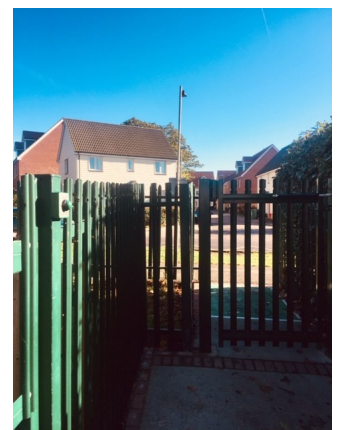
To further improve the safety of your children and security of the school site, a new gate has been installed at the main entrance.
