6TB—Rocco M for always approaching work with a positive attitude and using humour to overcome challenges.

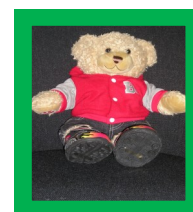

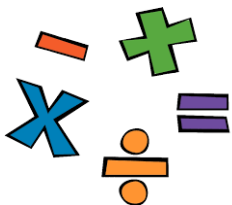
