- 6HS— Cadence H for working independently, quickly and carefully in reading lessons—Cadence has set a fantastic example.

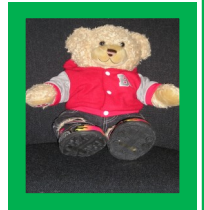

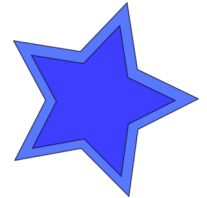
