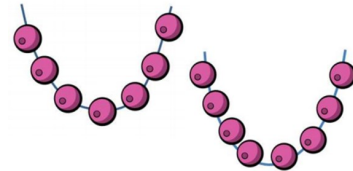


KS1 Problem of the Week
