- 6TB—Rocco M for always demonstrating an excellent attitude both in school and when representing The Willows at sporting events.

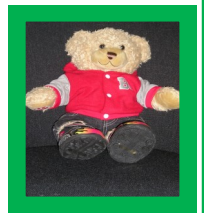


Attendance Matters

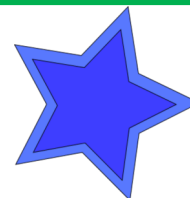

A barrel holds 7 bottles of juice.



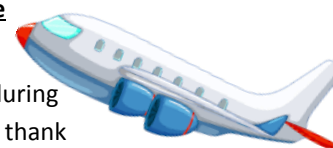
$$20\% \text{ of } \square = 12$$

Holidays During Term Time

We appreciate that most families decide to holiday during the school holidays and we thank you for your co-operation. If you do need to book a holiday during school time then you will need to complete a Leave of Absence form which must be agreed by the Headteacher in advance. It is recommended by the Government that as a general rule any activity, holiday or event that can be arranged during the annual 13 week holiday should not be authorised during the school term. Should a child absence result in a penalty, fines are issued by the Missing Education Department from Essex County Council who will contact you directly.
